Tenders from Integrated Contractor Development Programme (ICDP) of the DRPW Data Base are hereby invited for the Grass Cutting Bush Clearing and other Ancillary Works on R392 & R393 around Sterkspruit area within the Senqu Local Municipality area in the Joe Gqabi District.

The contract will be for **5 months** and the works will consist of grass cutting, bush clearance and other ancillary works on route R392 and R393 of approximately 105 km of surface roads on the provincial Road network at Senqu LMA.

Tender documents will be available as from **8H00 on Friday 22 April 2016** at the offices of the Department of Roads and Public Works, Block F, Bensonvale Office Complex, Sterkspruit, on payment of a non-refundable deposit of **R100.00** per document (CASH ONLY).

Completed tender documents in a sealed envelope endorsed with the project name, tender number and description must be deposited in the Tender Box, Department of Roads and Public Works, Block F, Bensonvale Office Complex, Sterkspruit, at **12:00am on Thursday 23 June 2016** when tenders will be

opened in public.

**Tenderers shall take note of the following tender conditions –**

- ❑ Bidders must be registered on the Centralized Electronic Supplier Database of the Eastern Cape Provisional Treasury.
- ❑ Project Value is in CIDB Grade 3 CE PE or 4CE only Category
- ❑ Tenderers are required to have a CIDB Contractor grading designation 3 CE PE or 4 CE
- ❑ Tenderers to tender within their CIDB category grade only (see above)
- ❑ Tenderers must submit a preliminary Occupational Health and Safety Plan with their tender. Failure to submit will not be considered.
  
- ❑ Irrespective of the date of evaluation, bidders will be eliminated at Bid Evaluation Stage if their CIDB status is non-compliant. Therefore bidders are responsible to ensure that their CIDB status remains compliant for the entire validity period and up to the date of award.
- ❑ An approved surety will be required
- ❑ Penalties for late completion will be enforced
- ❑ Late tenders will not be accepted
- ❑ Failure to complete all supplementary information and the RETURNABLE SCHEDULES like SDB 1, 4, SDB 6.1, SDB8 and SDB 9 will result in limited chances of tender being awarded
- ❑ Preferential Procurement Regulation 2011 (B-BBEE) principles will apply, whereby a tenderer's submission will be evaluated according to the sum of the Award of Points in respect of the tender value and the status of the enterprise
- ❑ Adjudication criteria are as follows:
  - ❑ 90 Points for Price
  - ❑ 10 Points for B-BBEE status level of Contribution
  
- ❑ A copy of a valid B-BBEE Status Level Verification Certificate must be submitted in order to qualify for preference points for B-BBEE. Sworn affidavits from the Commissioner of Oath stipulating the status level of contribution are also acceptable
- ❑ Tender Forms (Form C1.1: Form of offer and acceptance) that are incomplete or incorrectly completed will result in limited chances of being awarded.
- ❑ A valid original SARS Tax Clearance Certificate (SDB 2) must be submitted with the tender, in order to be considered.
- ❑ Form T2.2r (Compulsory Enterprise Questionnaire) must be completed by all parties to a JV or the tender will result in limited chances of being awarded.
- ❑ Cipro/CIPC Certificate and ID copies of members/directors/owner of the company to be submitted with bid.
- ❑ The validity period will be 90 days.

Telegraphic, telexed or faxed tenders will not be considered.
