- 1. This circular is issued in terms of recruitment measures contained in the Public Service Regulations, 2001 Chapter VII C 2 and in this regard it is important to note that the Public Service is an EQUAL OPPORTUNITIES, AFFIRMATIVE ACTION EMPLOYER.

Post 5: Material Testers (X2 posts)

Sub - Component: Laboratory

Centre: In House Construction (Grahamstown)
Salary Notch: R196 278 per annum (Level 7)

Requirements: *NQF Level 4 or equivalent with 6 years' experience in the Road Construction environment *2 of the 6 years in the Road Material testing environment *A valid driver's license Code 8

Duties: * Perform laboratory tests without supervision i.e. soils, concrete, asphalt and chemical tests * Perform field tests and investigations i.e. center line and borrow pits * Operate and calibrate of testing apparatus including density gauges (troxler etc.) * Plan and report test and investigation results to the laboratory manager * Computer literacy (basic skills)

Sub- Component: Laboratory

Centre: In House Construction (Grahamstown) Salary Notch: R158 985 per annum (Level 6)

Requirements: * NQF Level 4 with 4 years' experience in the Road construction environment and 1 of the 4 years to be in a road material testing environment * A Valid Code 8 driver's license

Duties: * Assist with the performance of laboratory tests i.e. soils, concrete, asphalt and chemical tests * Assist with the performance of field tests and investigations i.e. center line and borrow pits * Assist with operating and calibrating of testing apparatus including density gauges (troxler etc.) * Assist with the planning and reporting tests and investigation results to the laboratory manager * Computer literacy (basic skills)

Post 7: Chief Auxilliary Services Officer (Safety)

Sub- Component: Laboratory

Centre: In House Construction (Grahamstown) Salary Notch: R196 278 per annum (Level 7)

Requirements: * NQF Level 4 with 6 years' experience in the Safety - Health (SHE) environment *A valid driver's license - Code 8 *Sound knowledge of Safety and Health Environment Act *Computer literacy *Good verbal and written communication *Organizing and presentation skills

Duties: *Conduct daily site safety inspections and update Safety Plan, ensure that construction sites adhere to all Safety standards and requirements * Establish and convene Safety Committee's * Prepare and submit monthly reports to the Road Works Assistant Manager *Manage the issuing of PPE/PPC and keep records * Conduct daily tool box talks and keep records *Identify all areas that might pose danger and fatalities to the public and put controls in place *Comply with the procedures of the PMDS *Ensure traffic accommodation procedures are implemented daily.

Sub- Component: Road Works

Centre: In House Construction (Grahamstown)
Salary Notch: R196 278 per annum (Level 7)

Requirements: * The minimum ABET level is required *More than 15 years Plant Operator experience * 10 out of the 15 Years should have been a Road Works Foreman *Ability to give and receive instructions in either Xhosa, English or Afrikaans * Valid driver's license Code C1

Duties: * Overall supervision of site road works activities *Plan and prepare a weekly site programme *Ensure signing of daily log sheets of hired plant and supervise hired plant *Train road senior and junior foreman where needed * Ensure that daily milestones and weekly milestones are met * Take responsibility for quality of site road works * Ensure traffic safety management before and during construction *Conduct tool box talks with OHS Officer *Ensure survey settings is done by the site surveyor

Post 9: Road Works Foreman
Component: Road Works

Centre: In House Construction (Grahamstown) Salary Notch: R132 399 per annum (Level 5)

Requirements: *The minimum ABET level is required *More than 8 Years' experience as a Plant Operator *Ability to give and receive instructions in either Xhosa, English or Afrikaans *A valid driver's license (Code C1).

Duties: * Supervising plant operators*Plan and prepare weekly section programme *Sign daily log sheets of hired plant and supervise hired plant *Train road operators where *Ensure that daily tasks and weekly milestones are met *Take responsibility for quality of site road works *Supervise related personnel

DIRECTIONS TO CANDIDATES
