The Eastern Cape Department of Roads and Public Works (DRPW) is contributing towards skills development by providing graduates with opportunities to gain work experience in various skills areas. The Department invites applications for internship opportunities that currently exist in the Department of Roads and Public Works, Eastern Cape. Unemployed graduate applicants between 18 - 35 years of age who have never participated in an internship programme in any Government Department are invited to apply. Persons with Disability are encouraged to apply.

Objectives of the Internship Programme are:

- •To provide unemployed graduates with the necessary working experience and skills to close the gap between the academic theory and practical work.
- To provide unemployed graduates with valuable work experience and skills to enhance the employability.
 To improve equitable access to public sector employment for rural and marginalised groups such as women and the people living with disability.
- •To increase awareness among graduates of job and career opportunities in the Public Service.

- To qualify for this internship programme, you must:

 •be an unemployed South African graduate residing within the Eastern Cape Province.

 •have completed a degree / national diploma (NQF 6) or Honours & Masters in any of the following fields of study.

Only unemployed or Under-employed applicants between the ages of 18 – 35 will be considered. Successful applicants will be placed in various regions throughout the province and should thus apply for a position available in the region where they would like to be placed.

The internship programme is offered for a period of 12 months. Successful applicants will be appointed on contract commencing 1 April 2017 – 31 March 2018 and will be required to sign an internship contract with the Eastern Cape Department of Roads and Public Works.

Interns will receive a stipend of R 5 000.00 per month.
